### Global study:

According to a WHO study, about 830 women die every day as a result of pregnancy and childbirth-related causes. In developing countries, the death rate from caesarean sections is 100 times higher than in developed countries. "One in every 100 women in Sub-Saharan Africa who has a caesarean section will die," according to a new WHO study, "100 times more than women in the UK." According to previous estimates, the global maternal mortality ratio has only decreased by 2.3 percent. Between 2000 and 2010, the maternal mortality ratio declined at a faster rate of 5.5 percent, and by 2015, it had risen to 44 percent. Reduce global maternal mortality to less than 70 per 100,000 live births between 2016 and 2030 as part of a sustainable development target.
