About City and Venue





Zurich is Switzerland's largest city and the seat of the canton of Zurich. It is situated at the north-western tip of Lake Zürich in north-central Switzerland. The Swiss National Museum and Kunsthaus are among the cities several museums and art galleries. In the German-speaking world, the Schauspielhaus Zurich is regarded as one of the most important theatres. Zurich has an oceanic climate, but it is classified as a humid continental climate with warm summers and four distinct seasons in the higher elevations.

Spring and autumn are usually cool to moderate, but even within the same year, there can be significant variations between warm and cold days. In October, the lowest average daily temperature was- $16 \, ^{\circ}\text{C} \, (3 \, ^{\circ}\text{F})$ and the highest average daily temperature was $20 \, ^{\circ}\text{C} \, (68 \, ^{\circ}\text{F})$.

The vast forest areas of Adlisberg, Zurichberg, Kaferberg, Honggerberg, and Uetliberg serve as the city's "green lungs." Along the lakeshore, two major parks (Zurichhorn and Enge) are located, while smaller parks are scattered throughout the area. The Prehistoric Pile Dwellings around the Alps, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, includes the prehistoric settlements at Enge Alpenquai, Grosser Hafner, and Kleiner Hafner.

The Zurich Film Festival is an 11-day international film festival that showcases well-known international productions. The Street Parade, which is also one of the world's largest techno and dance music festivals, is one of Zürich's largest and most famous annual events. It is usually held on the second Saturday in August and runs along the shore of Lake Zürich. The Zürifäscht, on the other hand, is a public festival held every three years. It includes music, choreographed fireworks, and other attractions in the historic district. It is Switzerland's biggest public festival, attracting up to 2 million tourists
