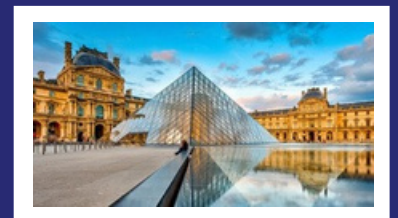
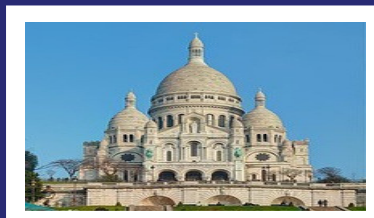
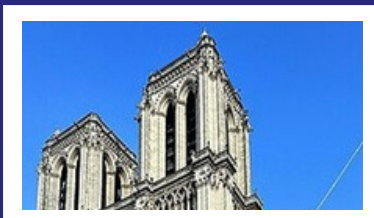
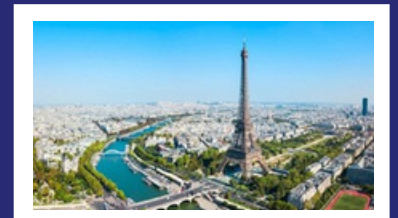
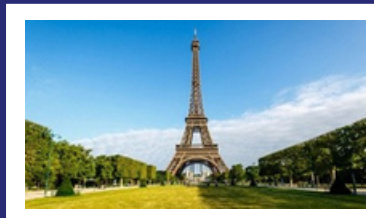




About Venue:
